Buildings & Development Overview

Located at Sunnydale Avenue and Hahn St., Sunnydale HOPE SF Building 3A and Building 3B are two adjacent mixed-use new construction buildings comprising approximately 170 affordable residential units and 30,000 square feet of ground floor retail and community amenities in San Francisco's Visitacion Valley neighborhood. Seventy-five percent of the residential units in these buildings will serve as replacement Sunnydale households, while the remaining 25% will serve as affordable housing for households at 60% Area Median Income (AMI).



These two buildings anchor the new neighborhood center at Sunnydale and Visitacion Valley, fostering an inclusive, familyfriendly space for play, dining, and learning. The development supports health, wellness, and education with:

- Building 3 (3A & 3B): 26,600 sq. ft. of commercial space, including an early childhood center (Felton Institute), a wellness center (SFDPH), a resource center (Mercy Housing), a healthy grocer, a micro food hall, a coffee shop and seven small retail spaces.
- The Hub: A 29,000 sq. ft. community center with a Boys & Girls Clubhouse, Wu Yee ECE, and multi-purpose spaces.
- Herz Park Recreation Center: An 11,500 sq. ft. facility with a gymnasium and multi– purpose room.
- Park & Open Spaces
